For the purpose of this policy, the term “Enterprise” means Enterprise Products Partners L.P., Enterprise Products Company, and their respective affiliates and subsidiaries. - Through ongoing implementation, use an EHS management system approach to establish goals, implement programs, evaluate progress, and continually improve performance;

- Promote a safe workplace by managing significant health and safety risks associated with all aspects of our business;
- Cardinal Rules of Safety, safety policies, procedures, and practices are critical to a safe work environment and should be followed at all times;
- Promote a culture in which all employees share the commitment of health and safety excellence and recognize this requires a personal involvement of all levels of management and all employees;
- Promote health and safety awareness and responsibility through training to ensure employees are competent to perform their assignments effectively and safely;
- Maintain a state of readiness for effective spill and incident response to minimize potential threats to public safety and the environment;
- Commit to being a good neighbor in the communities where we operate;
- Communicate our health and safety commitments, responsibilities and performance to our employees, contractors, regulators, and the public;
- Audit our assets and operations for compliance with laws, regulations, policies, and practices regularly, and implement the appropriate corrective actions.
